- ; Between 1 and 19 April in 2010, in the conference hall of Science and Social Arts Faculty, a meeting and education session for the members of Disabled Students Center were held and a guideline was prepared.
- ; The first spring fest was celebrated with the motto "no disability to have fun" together with the other institutions giving services to the disabled in Karabük .
- ; Certificate of Participation was given to the students who have attended the Photography Education project for the disabled by our Rector, Prof. Dr Burhanettin Uysal.
- ; Academic and Administrative unit meetings were held on 12 August 2010 .
- ; Briefing meeting was held on 01 October 2010
- ; A course book for a Student Studying in the Foreign Language School was published in larger font size so that he could read and a contact was established in case he needed help.
- ; A conference was held by SMYO and Ahmet Yavuz Kocaömer, the Head of National Paralympics Committee was invited.
- ; A talk with Eşref Armağan was held.
- ; Asst. Prof. Dr. Talat BAYBURTLUOGLU attended to 5th Disabled Universities Meeting" in Ankara.
- ; In Bartın University, Karabük and Zonguldak Karaelmas universities held the 1st Local Disabled Meeting and they discussed ways to find conveniences for students on Campus areas.

Higher Education Council (YÖK)

According to Board Decision taken on 23/02/1990 for disabled students to select other elective courses and for compulsory courses to be successful if these courses hinder their abilities, and this decision was reconsidered on 21/07/2006 08/10/2009 and approved to be right in accordance with law number 2547. According to law numbered as 5378, It was added that the educational rights of disabled people cannot be prevented on no condition, for disabled people, regarding their disabilities, equal educational rights are provided with the other people. For the above mentioned reasons, the regulation of YÖK published on 21/07/2006, for the vocational proficiency of courses in higher education institutions was cancelled. Provided students apply, the equal courses have to be provided, if not, the curriculum has to be designed for the students' needs.

3. If the disabled students has visual loss, the exam has to be carried out in an isolated room by a siter.
